(Whereupon, the following proceedings were duly had:)

THE COURT: Okay. So we are calling the case of State of Minnesota versus John Thomas Myser, Junior. This is Court File 70-VB-19-5703. We are set for a court trial today. At the hearing on September 30th, 2019, the prosecutor chose to certify this as a petty misdemeanor, which means it was going to be set as a court trial, and so we're going to go forward with that today, if we could have everybody who is sitting at counsel table identify themselves, starting with the State.

MR. HAYEK: Michael Hayek for the State.

THE COURT: Okay. And who are you, sir?

MR. MYSER: Good morning, ma'am. I am here appearing in the identity of the person John Thomas Myser, Junior. And if I said otherwise, I would be lying.

THE COURT: Okay. Are you John Myser, Junior?

MR. MYSER: I -- I am John Thomas Myser,
Junior, and I am appearing in the identity of the
person whose name is John Thomas Myser, Junior. And
if I claimed to be him, I would be lying. I am not
the person, ma'am.

THE COURT: Okay. So you are not John 1 2 Myser, Junior. Correct? 3 I am John Thomas Myser, Junior, MR. MYSER: 4 and I am appearing in the identity of the person John 5 Thomas Myser, Junior, but I am not the person -- I am 6 not the person John Thomas Myser, Junior. 7 THE COURT: Okay. Sir, are you aware that 8 the defendant, the person John Thomas Myser, Junior, 9 must attend his own court trial? Are you aware of 10 that? 11 MR. MYSER: Ma'am, I was given a notice to 12 appear by a police officer --13 THE COURT: Answer the question. Are you 14 aware that John Thomas Myser, Junior, is required to 15 appear today for this trial? MR. MYSER: That's right. That's what I'm 16 doing, ma'am. I am appearing --17 18 THE COURT: Okay. 19 MR. MYSER: -- for the person John Thomas 20 Myser, Junior. Is that correct?

MR. MYSER: I am not in fact the person John
Thomas Myser, Junior, that's correct, ma'am.

THE COURT: Mr. Hayek, given the fact that John Thomas Myser, Junior, the person, has not appeared today, is there any relief you would request in this case?

MR. HAYEK: If the individual sitting next to me to my left is representing that John Thomas Myser, Junior, who has been cited, is not present, then that would be a failure to appear. If the person sitting next to me is the same person who was cited, then we can go forward.

THE COURT: Okay. So Mr. -- sir, whoever you are, if you are the person John Thomas Myser, Junior, then I will note that the defendant has appeared and we'll proceed with the trial. If you deny being John Thomas Myser, Junior, then I am going to certify this as a conviction, I'm going to enter a conviction, and I'm going to fine John Thomas Myser, Junior, based upon the conviction -- based upon the failure to appear and Criminal Rule 23.05.

So, sir, it's your time to say whether you are John Thomas Myser, Junior, or not because if you are not, then I am going to find that the defendant has failed to appear and therefore a conviction should

be entered on this petty misdemeanor. Do you fully understand what I'm offering here?

MR. MYSER: So are you deeming — if I go through and I state, ma'am, that I am appearing for the person John Thomas Myser, Junior, as I was given both notice by citation and by the court notice that said I was to appear fully prepared, that I was to appear fully prepared, so "appear" means seems to be as opposed to reality, "appear" means to pretend to be.

So when I come here and I am pretending to be the person John Thomas Myser, Junior, is it not true, ma'am, that then you will deem me to be the person John Thomas Myser, Junior, by that act?

THE COURT: No. I need to hear it from you. The last time we had a hearing, you said that you were the attorney of record for John Thomas Myser, and I told you you can't appear unless you're licensed as an attorney in the state of Minnesota. So now I'm asking you are you the defendant John Thomas Myser, Junior, so we can move forward with the trial?

MR. MYSER: Ma'am, I am not going to lie. I am -- are you asking -- are you attempting to induce me to commit fraud here in court?

THE COURT: No, I'm just trying to figure

1	out whether the person, the defendant charged here, is
